



Clovis Fire, Fresno Fire & Cal Fire Departments Will Be Presenting RESIDENTIAL FIRE SPRINKLER OVERVIEW August 16, 2010, 8:30am – 5:00pm

COURSE OVERVIEW: A broad overview of residential fire sprinklers in one and two family dwellings, and an introduction to design concepts for the inspector and plans reviewer.

08:30am – 12:00pm: The morning session will be comprised of a summary of the development and adoption of the residential sprinkler code change and discussion of California amendments to the Residential Building Code and referenced standards pertaining to residential sprinklers.

1:00pm – 5:00pm: The afternoon session will include chapter by chapter review and comparison of NFPA 13D and CRC 313.3 (IRC P2904), and technical of the materials and devices commonly used in residential sprinkler installations, as well as an introduction to the new “prescriptive” pipe sizing method adopted in both standards.
